PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

February, 1959 RIV OF THE

Coal production during February amounted to 890,000 tons making a total production of 2,167,343 tons for the first two months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 24.1 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 322,586 tons, making a total of 667,134 tons imported during the first two months of this year. This was a decrease of 4.9 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during February are not yet available. There were 28,871 tons exported during February, 1958.
