PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION RTY OF THE

March, 1959

Coal production during March amounted to 692,000 tons making a total production of 2,885,490 tons for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 26.3 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 290,966 tons, making a total of 958,100 tons imported during the first three months of this year. This was a decrease of 3.0 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during March are not yet available. There were 25,993 tons exported in March 1958.
