#### PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

## June, 1959

Coal production during June amounted to 594,000 tons making a total production of 4,836,043 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 13.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,279,524 tons, making a total of 4,347,728 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was a decrease of 5.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during June are not yet available. There were 26,139 tons exported in June, 1958.
