PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

July, 1959

Coal production during July amounted to 692,000 tons, making a total production of 5,543,645 tons for the first seven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 0.8 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,680,733 tons, making a total of 6,028,461 tons imported during the first seven months of this year. This was a decrease of 0.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

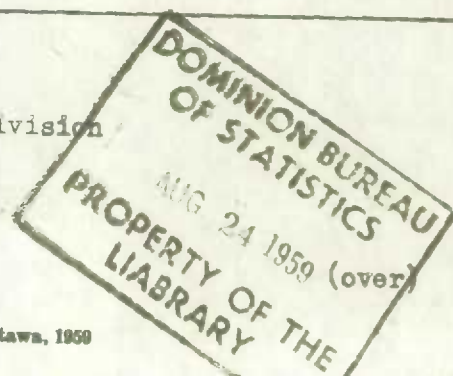
Data on coal exported during July are not yet available. There were 24,280 tons exported during July, 1958.
