## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

March. 1960

Coal production during the month amounted to 1,021,000 tons making a total production of 3,176,221 tons for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 45.0 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 199,751 tons, making a total of 567,700 tons imported during the first three months of this year. This was a decrease of 31.3 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during March are not yet available. There were 25,876 tons exported during March, 1959.
