PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

NOVEMBER, 1947

Coal production in Canada during November totalled 1,700,093 tons, which was 2 per cent lower than production in the previous month but an increase of 7.6 per cent over the quantity produced in November of last year.

Total production for the first eleven months of the year was 14,028,113 tons, a decline of 13.6 per cent compared with the output in the corresponding period of 1946.
