PRELIMINARY REFORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

DECEMBER - 1948

Coal production in Canada during December amounted to 1,791,000 tons making a total production of 18,376,718 tons for the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 1.3 per cent. Production for the year 1948 showed an increase of 15.8 per cent over that of 1947.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 1,282,148 tons, making a total of 31,049,632 tons imported during this year. This was a decrease of 49 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year, although imports for the year showed an increase of 1.5 per cent over these of 1947.

Coal exported during December amounted to 132,236 tons.
