PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

JULY - 1948

Coal production in Canada during July amounted to 1,356,626 tons making a total production of 9,874,410 tons for the first seven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 13 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 3,487,591 tons, making a total of 14,866,616 tons imported during the first seven months of this year. This was an increase of 3 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding period of last year.

Coal exported during July amounted to 81,564 tons.
