FRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

AUGUST - 1948

Coal production in Canada during August amounted to 1,369,300 tons making a total production of 11,243,710 tons for the first eight months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 12.5 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 4,370,179 tons, making a total of 19,236,795 tons imported during the first eight months of this year. This was an increase of 38 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during August amounted to 81.262 tons.
