PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1948

Coal production in Canada during September amounted to 1,546,100 tons making a total production of 12,789,810 tons for the first nine months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 77 tons.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 3,982,306 tons, making a total of 23,219,101 tons imported during the first nine months of this year. This was an increase of 2.5 percent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during September amounted to 199,024 tons.
