

## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

## OCTOBER, 1949

Coal production in Canada during October amounted to 1,900,500 tons making a total production of 15,034,800 tons for the first ten months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 4.9 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 771,749 tons, making a total of 17,036,638 tons imported during the first ten months of this year. This was a decrease of 77.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during October amounted to 42,452 tons.
