PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

MARCH, 1949

Coal production in Canada during March amounted to 1,701,000 tons making a total production of 5,202,000 tons for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 2.5 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 670,748 tons, making a total of 2,369,355 tons imported during the first three months of this year. a decrease of 44.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during March amounted to 34,164 tons.
