## RELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

## APRIL, 1949

Coal production in Canada during April amounted to 1,236,600 tons making a total production of 6,438,600 tons for the first four months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 22.9 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 2,008,505 tons, making a total of 4,377,860 tons imported during the first four months of this year. This was an increase of 94 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during April amounted to 17,418 tons.
