PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

MAY, 1949

Coal production in Canada during May amounted to 1,326,700 tons making a total production of 7,765,300 tons for the first five months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 2.6 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 3,347,099 tons, making a total of 7,724,959 tons imported during the first five months of this year. This was a decrease of .04 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during May amounted to 32,184 tons.
