PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

JUNE, 1949

Coal production in Canada during June amounted to 1,322,000 tons making a total production of 9,087,300 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 5.9 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 3,009,633 tons, making a total of 10,734,592 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was a decrease of 16 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 29,059 tons.
