AUGUST, 1949

Coal production in Canada during August amounted to 1,243,125 tons making a total production of 11,430,700 tons for the first eight months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 10.1 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 2,102,574 tons, making a total of 14,492,035 tons imported during the first eight months of this year. This was a decrease of 51.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during August amounted to 30,587 tons.
