PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

Price 10 cents

MARCH, 1950

Coal production in Canada during March amounted to 1,916,600 tons making a total production of 5,439,000 tons for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 13.8 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 1,042,751 tons, making a total of 2,038,568 tons imported during the first three months of this year. This was an increase of 55.5 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during March amounted to 87,214 tons.
