PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

OCTOBER, 1950

Coal production during October amounted to 1,753,000 tons making a total production of 15,050,755 tons for the first ten months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 9.2 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 3,321,735 tons, making a total of 23,008,882 tons imported during the first ten months of this year. This was an increase of 330.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during October amounted to 28,030 tons.
