## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

## NOVEMBER, 1950

Coal production during November amounted to 2,000,000 tons making a total production of 17,070,663 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 4.3 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,809,184 tons, making a total of 25,818,066 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was an increase of 89.6 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.
