

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION IN CANADA

Price 10 cents

APRIL, 1950

Coal production in Canada during April amounted to 1,308,500 tons making a total production of 6,747,500 tons for the first four months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 6.5 per cent.

Imports of coal into Canada during the month amounted to 2,247,941 tons, making a total of 4,286,509 tons imported during the first four months of this year. This was an increase of 11.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during April amounted to 42,114 tons.
