PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

JUNE. 1950

to production during June amounted to 1,341,000 tons making a total production of 2,588,609 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of one per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,934,595 tons, making a total of 10,432,508 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was a decrease of 2.5 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 20,693 tons.
