## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

## AUGUST, 1950

Coal production during August amounted to 1,051,150 tons making a total production of 11,751,759 tons for the first eight months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 17.7 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 3,053,294 tons, making a total of 16,395,456 tons imported during the first eight months of this year. This was an increase of 45.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during August amounted to 30,885 tons.
