PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

NOVEMBER 1951

Coal production during November amounted to 2,040,000 tons making a total production of 16,828,791 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 1.0 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,573,836 tons, making a total of 25,255,057 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was a decrease of 8.3 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during November amounted to 69,339 tons, compared with 37,725 tons exported in November 1950.
