PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

JUNE, 1951

Coal production during June amounted to 1,310,000 tons making a total production of 9,081,344 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 3.9 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,977,575 tons, making a total of 11,537,325 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was an increase of 1.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 21,279 tons, as compared with 20,693 tons exported in the same month of last year.
