PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

NOVEMBER - 1952

Coal production during November amounted to 1,640,000 tons, making a total production of 15,776,370 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 19.0 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,081,474 tons, making a total of 23,593,832 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was a decrease of 19.1 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last vear.

Coal exported during November amounted to 45,163 tons, as compared with 69.339 tons exported during the same month of last year.
