## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

## JUNE - 1952

Coal production during June amounted to 1,190,000 tons, making a total production of 8.734,923 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 8.7 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 3,018,514 tons, making a total of 11.311.824 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was an increase of 1.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 32,847 tons, as compared with 21,279 tons

exported during the same month of last year.
