PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

NOVEMBER - 1953 THE

Coal production during November amounted to 1,627,000 tons, making a total production of 14,229,306 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 1.9 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,930,690 tons, making a total of 21,927,137 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was a decrease of 7.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during November amounted to 22,324 tons, as compared with 45,163 tons exported during the same month of last year.
