## PRELTMTNARY PEPORT CN COAL PRCDUCTION <br> DECEMBER - 2953

Coal production during December amounted to $1,627,000$ tons making a total production of $15,856,306$ tons for the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 8.1 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 594,650 tons, making a total of $22,521,787$ tons imported during the year. This was a decrease of 36.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during December amounted to 19,572 tons, compared with 50,440 tons exported in December, 1952.
