JUNE - 1953

Coal production during June amounted to 1,120,000 tons, making a total production of 7,726,210 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 6.7 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,654,769 tons, making a total of 9,707,556 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was a decrease of 12.0 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 17,793 tons, as compared with 32,847 tons exported during the same month of last year.
