PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

JULY - 1953

Coal production during July amounted to 1,058,000 tons, making a total production of 8,784,210 tons for the first seven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 10.5 per cent.

Imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,520,979 tons, making a total of 12,228,535 tons imported during the first seven months of this year. This was an increase of .4 per cent, compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during July amounted to 20,604 tons, as compared with 26,122 tons exported during the same month of last year.
