## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during November amounted to 1,563,000 tons, making a total production of 13,302,804 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 4.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,049,282 tons, making a total of 17,716,161 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was an increase of 6.1 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during November amounted to 28,025 tons, as compared with 22,324 tons exported during the same month of last year.
