## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during April amounted to 1,117,000 tons making a total production of 5,387,852 tons for the first four months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 1.0 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,339,374 tons, making a total of 3,142,302 tons imported during the first four months of this year. This was a decrease of 27.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during April amounted to 16,136 tons, as compared with 17,209 tons exported in April, 1953.
