PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during June amounted to 1,050,000 tons making a total production of 7,407,283 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 6.9 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,010,649 tons, making a total of 7,214,247 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was a decrease of 24.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 17,739 tons, as compared with 17,793 tons exported in June, 1953.
