## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during October amounted to 1,400,000 tons, making a total production of 11,240,349 tons for the first ten months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 1.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,993,375 tons, making a total of 16,295,821 tons imported during the first ten months of this year. This was a decrease of 12.5 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during October amounted to 36,437 tons, as compared with 24,636 tons exported during the same month of last year.
