PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during November amounted to 1,710,000 tons, making a total production of 12,959,664 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 7.5 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,023,596 tons, making a total of 18,319,417 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was a decrease of 1.3 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during November are not yet available. There were 28,025 tons exported during November, 1954.
