## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during February amounted to 1,276,000 tons making a total production of 2,724,581 tons for the first two months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 7.3 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 605,132 tons, making a total of 1,194,430 tons imported during the first two months of this year. This was a decrease of 9.6 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during February amounted to 17,946 tons, as compared with 17,533 tons exported in February, 1954.
