## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during March amounted to 1,380,000 tons making a total production of 4,098,325 tons for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 8.1 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 574,130 tons, making a total of 1,768,560 tons imported during the first three months of this year. This was an increase of 6.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during March amounted to 72,222 tons, as compared with 14,818 tons exported in March, 1954.
