## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during April amounted to 950,000 tons making a total production of 5,068,686 tons for the first four months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 15.3 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,877,897 tons, making a total of 3,646,457 tons imported during the first four months of this year. This was an increase of 28.7 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during April amounted to 51,288 tons, as compared with 16,136 tons exported in April, 1954.
