PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during June amounted to 925,000 tons making a total production of 7,007,157 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 13.4 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,319,840 tons, making a total of 8,266,189 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was an increase of 15.3 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during June amounted to 25,577 tons, as compared with 17,739 tons exported in June, 1954.
