## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during July amounted to 781,000 tons making a total production of 7,799,338 tons for the first seven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 10.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,798,291 tons, making a total of 10,064,480 tons imported during the first seven months of this year. This was a decrease of 1.0 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during July amounted to 34,906 tons, as compared with 14,448 tons exported in July, 1954.
