PROPERTY OF THE

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during August amounted to 767,900 tons making a total production of 8,567,238 tons for the first eight months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 3.6 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,139,850 tons, making a total of 12,204,330 tons imported during the first eight months of this year. This was a decrease of 5.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during August amounted to 29,306 tons, as compared with 19,320 tons exported in August, 1954.
