According to the American Bureau of Metal Statistics refined copper stocks in North and South America increased 24,121 tons in September to a total of 479,896 tons and blister copper stocks recorded an advance of 2,320 tons to 178,425 tons. World copper output (based on the copper content of blister as reported by smelters) has shown little variation since June. In September, 120,655 tons were produced; the August output was 121,655 tons and the July total, 121,504 tons.
