COPPER AND NICKEL PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1935.

COPPER - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that Canada produced 33,480,418 pounds of copper in January; during the preceding month 31,370,556 pounds were produced, while in January, 1934, the output totalled 26,514,543 pounds.

Quotations for electrolytic copper on the London market in Canadian funds averaged 6.8202 cents per pound in January at which price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$2,283,431. The average price in December was 6.78133 cents per pound and the value of the month's production was \$2,127,341.

The world production of refined copper in January amounted to 122,800 tons as compared with 121,922 tons in December and 91,300 tons in January, 1934. World stocks of refined copper totalled 476,100 tons on January 31st; this represented a decline of 7,175 tons during the month.

Northern Rhodesia produced 14,131 tons of copper as against 8,637 tons, a German refinery production of copper advanced to 12,989 tons from the January, 1934, total of 12,214 tons. Imports of copper into Germany in January were recorded at 13,529 tons; during the corresponding month of the previous year 18,226 tons were imported.


