MONTHLY REPORT

COPPER AND NICKEL PRODUCTION IN CANADA - DECEMBER, 1935.

COPPER - Canada produced 36,556,119 pounds of copper during December, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In November, 34,539,762 pounds were produced while in December, a year ago, the production amounted to 31,289,007 pounds. During the calendar year 1935 the Canadian output totalled 419,051,056 pounds which was 14.9 per cent above the production in the preceding year. An advance of 16.5 per cent was recorded in the output of blister copper in Canada during December as compared with the total for the corresponding month of 1934; the totals were 32,683,362 pounds and 28,042,461 pounds, respectively.

Electrolytic copper quotations on the London market in December averaged 8.73224 cents per pound, in Canadian funds; during the preceding month the average price was 8.75435 cents per pound. Computed at these prices the value of the Canadian output in December was \$3,192,162 and in November, \$3,023,732.

Refined copper production of the world advanced to 141,700 tons from the November total of 131,600 tons. Shipments of refined copper during December totalled 132,588 tons with the result that stocks on hand at the end of the month were 9,112 tons higher at 485,328 tons. An increase of 10,415 tons was recorded in the United States stocks during December and the month closed with 231,415 tons on hand. Stocks in other countries declined 1,303 tons in December to 253,913 tons. The official warehouses of the London Metal Exchange contained 86,171 tons of refined copper and 11,608 tons of rough copper on December 31st us compared with 87,030 tons of the former and 11,853 tons of the latter on hand on November 30th.


Exports of refined copper from the United States in December amounted to 19,546 tons or 13.7 per cent below the tonnage exported in November. Exports during December were consigned to the following countries: Italy, 5,878 tons; France, 2,984 tons; Great Britain, 2,543 tons; Germany, 2,340 tons; Japan, 2,030 tons; Sweden, 1,861 tons, and other countries, 1,910 tons.

Great Britain imported 171,109 tons of electrolytic copper during the celendar year 1935 as against 123,496 tons imported in the proceeding year. Canada accounted for 45.7 per cent of the 1935 imports and 51.5 per cent of the 1934 total. Receipts of other unwrought copper during the year were recorded at 166,570 tons, an increase of 5.7 per cent over the tonnage imported in 1934.



During November 12,144,249 pounds were produced while in December, 1934, the output totalled 10,703,716 pounds. Nickel output during the calendar year 1935 rose to 138,087,781 pounds from the 1934 total of 128,687,340 pounds.
