MONTHLY REPORT

COPPER and NICKEL PRODUCTION IN CANADA - AUGUST, 1938.

COPPER - The Canadian output of copper during August totalled 49,321,991 pounds; in July, 49,607,247 pounds were produced while in August, 1937, the output amounted to 44,549,447 pounds, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the first eight months of the current year increased 18.5 per cent to 390,978,155 pounds from the output of 330,034,102 pounds in the corresponding months of 1937. Blister copper production in August was recorded at 42,137,133 pounds compared with 41,415,831 pounds in the preceding month.

Copper quotations on the London market in August averaged 10.034 cents per pound, in Canadian funds; valued at this price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$4,948,969. The July average price was 9.846 cents per pound and the computed value of the month's cutout was \$4,884,330.


The refined copper production of the world in August was estimated at 148,908 tons compared with 139,483 tons in July. The United States output rose 2,457 tons in August to 38,055 tons; domestic deliveres and exports increased 15.1 per cent to 62,832 tons with the result that stocks decreased 24,779 tons during the month to 315,191 tons. An increase of 6.7 per cent was recorded in production in countries other than the United States when 110,855 tons were produced; deliveries totalled 129,509 tons (including 14,761 tons imported from the United States), therefore stocks decreased 3,893 tons to 179,335 tons.

Exports of refined copper (foreign, refined in bond, and domestic) from the United States declined 6,486 tons to 32,607 tons in August. The month's exports consisted of 15,781 tons consigned to Germany, 5,291 tons to Japan, 2,100 tons to Poland and Danzig, 1,849 tons to Italy, 1,608 tons to France, 1,468 tons to Great Britain, 1,257 tons to Czechoslovakia, 1,131 tons to the Netherlands, and 2,072 tons to other countries.
