MONTHLY REPORT

COPPER and NICKEL PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1939.

COPPER - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the Canadian output of copper in February amounted to 41,218,288 pounds; in January, 48,257,536 pounds were produced while in February, 1938, the output was 46,835,955 pounds. Production during the first two months of 1939 totalled 89,475,824 pounds or 9.9 per cent below the output in the corresponding period of 1938. Blister copper production in February declined to 35,085,586 pounds from the preceding month's total of 41,303,435 pounds.

Quotations for copper on the London market in February averaged 9.959 cents per pound, in Canadian funds; valued at this price the Canadian output during the month was worth 4,104,929. The January average price was 10.174 cents per pound and the computed value of the Canadian production was 4,909,722.


The refined copper production of the world amounted to 162,653 tons in February compared with 173,480 tons in January. A decline of 6,957 tons was recorded in the United States output to 59,225 tons; domestic deliveries and exports totalled 51,377 tons with the result that stocks at the end of the month were 7,848 tons higher at 308,958 tons. Production in countries other than the United States was 3.6 per cent lower at 103,428 tons while stocks increased 5,207 tons during the month to 184,156 tons.

Exports of refined copper from the United States in February amounted to 20,843 tons and consisted of 5,878 tons to Japan, 3,616 tons to Sweden, 2,357 tons to Germany, 2,317 tons to France, 1,978 tons to Italy, 1,798 tons to Great Britain, and 2,899 tons to other countries.

PRODUCTION OF COPPER IN CANADA



NICKEL - The Canadian output of nickel in February rose to 17,495,366 pounds from the preceding month's total of 14,611,017 pounds. In February, 1938, Canada produced 16,008,523 pounds. During the first two months of the current year nickel production totalled 32,106,383 pounds; this represented an 11.5 per cent falling-off from the output a year ago.
