## MONTHL, Y REPORT

## COPPER MMD IICKEL PIODUCTION LH CAVADA = JUNE, 1944

COPPER - The Canadian production of copper in June, 1944 amounted to 47,747,056 pounds accor iins to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In May, 1944, 48, 359,040 pounds were produced, while in June, 1943 the output totallod $46,347,568$ pounds. During the first six months of the current year, Canada produced $236,719,761$ pounds of copper compared wit: $297,416,474$ pounds during tine corresponding period of 1943.

NIKKEL .- Nickel production in Canada for the month of June, 1344 vias recorded at $20,373,599$ pounds, compared with $24,023,396$ pounds in the preceding montin and $25,734,494$ pounds in June, 1943.
