GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA, SEPTEMBER, 1932.

Canadian gold production during the first nine months of 1932 reached a total of 2,271,842 ounces valued at \$46,963,141 as compared with 1,974,204 ounces worth \$40,810,417 produced in the corresponding period of 1931, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In September, 260,538 ounces were produced; the output during the preceding month was 262,590 ounces and in September a year ago, 243,169 ounces were extracted.

The total production from Ontario mines in September declined 2.5 per cent to 189,721 ounces from the previous month's output of 194,616 ounces. During the month under review the Kirkland Lake field produced 92,593 ounces, the Porcupine camp, 89,683 ounces, and other sources, 7,445 ounces. Compared with the preceding month, Ankerite, Hollinger and Sylvanite, recorded increased outputs in September. The Toburn mill, formerly the Tough-Oakes-Burnside, in the Kirkland Lake field commenced operations on August 4th and this month's total includes the first shipments from the mill.

Quebec operators reported an output of 34,205 ounces, an increase of 22.2 per cent over the preceding month's production of 28,000 ounces.

In British Columbia, 16,023 ounces were produced as compared with 18,577 ounces in August and 16,705 ounces in July.

Manitoba produced 12,617 ounces in September, during the previous month the output was 14,259 ounces and in July the total was 9,646 ounces.


Placer production in the Yukon rose to 7,554 ounces from the August output of 7,133 ounces. Shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint from Nova Scotia totalled 418 ounces.

The Transvaal gold production in September was recorded at 961,501 ounces as compared with 916,024 ounces, a year ago. During the nine menths ending September the output from the Transvaal aggregated 8,619,265 ounces or 806,616 ounces above the total for the corresponding menths of 1931, according to a statement by "Metal and Mineral Markets."
