GOLD PHODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEIBER, 1933.
Canada's gold production in November, valued at the standard rate of $\$ 20.671834$ per ounce, was worth $\$ 4,981,271$, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at ottriwa. The month's output was 240,969 ounces as compared with 243,264 ounces in October and 247,446 ounces in November, 1932. During the ileven months onding Novamber, 1933. Canade produced 2,689,969 ounces of new cold; in the corresponding period of 1932 the preduction was 2,782,209 ounces.

Ontario's gold output in Novenver totylled 173,390 ounces consisting of 87,673 ounces from the Porcupine carnp, 79,069 ounces from the Kirkland lake fiold and 6,648 ounces from other sources. In the proceding month 166,460 ounces were produced of which tho Porcupinc camp contributod 80,300 ouncos, the Kirkland Lake fiuld, 79,982 ounces, and cther sources, 6,178 ounces. In November 483,867 tons of ore were millod by Ontario gold mining companius as compared with 479,105 tons a yoar ago. During tho first eleven months of 1933 ontario mills treated $5,118,365$ tons of ore, an advance of 1.0 per cunt over the tonnage treated in the corrusponding period of 1932.

Gold production in QuGbuc amounted to 33,777 ounces; in the preceding month 34,798 ounces were produced.

In British Columbia 20,476 ounces were extracted as compared with 19,987 ouncos in October.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan mines producce 8,961 ounces in November; during the precoding manth 14,389 ounces wore produced.

Nova Scotia and Alborta shipments of gold to the Foyal Canadian Mint amountad to 130 ounces in November.

Jewellery and scrap rucoived at the Foyal Canadian Mint in November contained 10,0 ounces of gold as against 9,012 ounces in the proceding month. During the eleven months ending Novomber, jowellery and scrap shipments to the Mint contalned 64,354 ounces of gold.

On tho London market, quotations for gold, in Canadian funds, rose to a high of $\$ 34.15$ per ounce on the fifteenth of Novomber but duclined to a law of $\$ 31.76$ per ounce on the twonty-seventh, with an average for the month of $\$ 32.68$ per ounce. In October, quotations averaged $\% 31.474$ per ounce

The estimatud gold production of the world in Novomber was 2,064,000 ounces as compared with $2,067,000$ ounces in October. Output during the eloven months onding Novomber, 1933, totalled 21,907,000 ouncer. Transvarl's production in November duclined to 898,000 ounces from the october total of 909,000 ounces. In the United States (including the Phǐippines) 256,634 ounces were produced as against 251,227 ounces in October.
