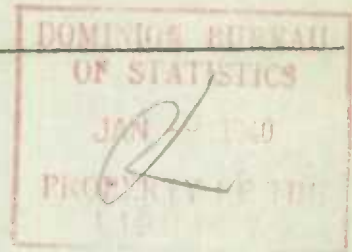

MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1939

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics reports that the Canadian output of gold in October rose to 432,678 ounces from the preceding month's total of 421,485 ounces and the October, 1938 production of 412,841 ounces. During the ten months ending October, Canada produced 4,235,880 ounces; this represented an increase of 9.2 per cent over the output a year ago.

Ontario operators reported an output of 266,376 ounces made up of 114,686 ounces from the Porcupine field, 87,657 ounces from the Kirkland Lake area and 64,033 ounces from other sources. In September, the Porcupine camp produced 105,069 ounces, the Kirkland Lake area 79,911 ounces and other sources, 62,432 ounces.

The Quebec production in October amounted to 75,676 ounces or 3 per cent above the output a year ago. Production in this province during the first ten months of the current year aggregated 796,039 ounces.

Operators in British Columbia produced 49,036 ounces of gold in October compared with 52,342 ounces in the corresponding month of 1938. The output in this province during the calendar year to date totalled 526,511 ounces.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 23,197 ounces as against 22,636 ounces in the preceding month; during the period January to October, 214,497 ounces were produced.

The Yukon's alluvial gold production and the Northwest Territories' lode gold output declined to 16,283 ounces in October from the September total of 17,567 ounces.

The Royal Canadian Mint received 2,047 ounces of gold from Nova Scotia in October; during the previous month, 2,415 ounces were received from that source.

The average price of gold, in Canadian funds, in October was \$38.431 per ounce; based on this price, the month's output in Canada was worth \$16,628,248. In September, gold averaged \$37.208 per ounce and the estimated value of the production during the month was \$15,682,614.

Receipts of jewellery and scrap at the Royal Canadian Mint in October contained 950 ounces of gold, thus making the gold content of these receipts during the calendar year to date, 10,297 ounces.

The output of gold in South Africa, Canada and the United States, in thousands of fine ounces, during the ten months ending October, 1938 and 1939, was as follows:-
